Accommodation

In April 2021 the Trust opened it's brand new accommodation residences for staff.

This accommodation offers staff a range of one, two and four bedroom apartments.

The buildings are owned by Yeovil Hospital and run by Simply Serve Ltd, a subsidiary company of Yeovil Hospital.

The site is located just a five minute walk from the hospital and just a short walk to the local shops, restaurants and leisure facilities in town.

Prices for new accommodation

One bedroom apartment (whole apartment)	£780 per apartment per month
Two bedroom apartment	£520 per room per month
Four bedroom apartment	£510 per room per month

The apartments are fully furnished and the rental prices include all utility bills (water, electricity and council tax) and free WiFi. One months deposit is required on all rentals and rent is paid one month in advance.

Short term rentals

For staff looking for temporary or short-term accommodation, we have availability in our Convamore Building, located on-site. Single rooms are available with shared access to kitchen and bathroom.

All rooms have a single bed, study desk and wash basin. Rooms are available on a nightly basis. Longer periods can be booked, up to a maximum of five months.



Schools and local area

Parents moving into South Somerset, or those wishing to start a family, will have a wealth of educational facilities on their doorstep. As well as a choice of state primary, secondary and further education facilities, the area also boasts a number of private schools with excellent reputations.

Access to academic excellence at a higher level is unparalleled, with Bristol University, the University of the West of England (Bristol) and Bath University approximately an hour away.
