BEDFORDSHIRE

Bedfordshire community health offer a rich and comprehensive variety of services to the adult population in the County. This includes community nursing & rapid response, end of life care, phlebotomy, wheelchair service and tissue viability.

Half the population is concentrated in two main urban centres and the remainder across the more sparsely populated rural parts of the County. This variety of environments, from comparatively wealthy areas to urban and rural poverty, creates its own challenges for healthcare provision. For staff this only adds to the variety of experience available and means we are a place where you can gain valuable new skills and build a long term and fulfilling career.

The County has excellent travel links and offers exciting and diverse working environments and career opportunities for healthcare staff interested in community working. Our close relationship with our local university is long established and creates excellent scope for staff to enhance their careers.

NEWHAM

We provide a range of community health services in Newham, including Extended Primary Care services, Specialist nursing and therapies including Diabetes, Continence, Cardiac and Neuro rehabilitation and Foot health. We also have an inpatient rehabilitation unit and specialist Learning Disability services.

Newham is a vibrant and diverse borough in which to work. Working in Community Health gives staff the opportunity to work in specialist or more generalist

roles and wherever you work you will be part of a strong and supportive team where your contribution will be valued and you will be trusted to provide the highest standard of care to our patients.

We encourage and support staff to continue their professional development via a number of routes including professional training courses and staff led quality improvement projects.

Tower Hamlets is a very diverse and vibrant inner London area. This brings rewards and challenges and also lots of interesting opportunities for people working in community health.

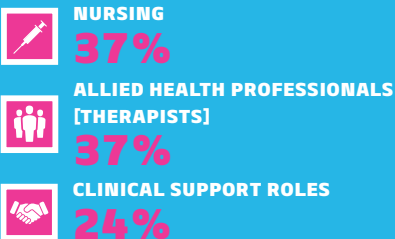
